### **DESCRIPTION**

Packaging of fresh fruit HASS Variety Avocado complies with a washing and disinfection, drying, calibrating and packaging. Corrugated cardboard boxes are used for avocados with export quality according to the standards of the destination, that is, healthy and clean fruits, with adequate maturity, free of wounds, blows, rot, damage by insects or pests and stains caused by cold.

Packaging is carried out according to the packaging specifications given in coordination with the client and the company, and which we will detail below in accordance with both parties.

### **ORGANOLEPTIC CHARACTERISTICS**

Color	Uniform green, characteristic of the variety
Form	Elongated to slightly oval, free of damage and dirt
Smell	Characteristic of fresh avocado, without strange odors
Texture	Firm, characteristic
Flavor	Characteristic, No foreign flavors

### **1. CALIBERS**

The calibers are packed according to the client's criteria.

There will be a tolerance of 10% of imbalance per box, in number or weight, of the fruits. that correspond to the caliber immediately higher or lower than that indicated on the packaging.

**2. WEIGHTS PER BOX**

At the same time, they must comply with uniformity in packaging such as origin, variety, color, caliber, quality.

**3. PACKAGING: TOLERABLE AND NON-TOLERABLE DEFECTS**

Minor defects will be tolerated, as long as they do not affect the general appearance of the product, its quality, state of conservation and presentation in the box. In no case

The defects must affect the pulp of the fruit.

Mechanical damage, fresh wounds, blows, bird droppings, damage from rodent or any other case that directly affects the pulp of the fruit or breaks the phytosanitary specifications (fruit fly, larva bite, queresas)

<p><b>RAMED.</b> Live his intensity not older than being covered by a finger and in one single area of fruit.</p>		
<p><b>LENTICELAS</b> Mild to moderate in a single area of the fruit and so much there has not been presented bumps or damage critics.</p>		
<p><b>DEFORMITY BY BED BED.</b> Live his deformations into pulp.</p>		

<p><b>THRIPS.</b> Mild and in a single area of the fruit.</p>		
<p><b>CHIMERA.</b> Live one coloration and dimension, without pronunciation or protuberances. It should not exceed 10% of the box.</p>	<p><b>Sí</b></p> 	
<p><b>DISCOLORATION N.</b> As long as it is not intense and occupies the entire area of the fruit.</p>	<p><b>Sí</b></p> 	<p><b>No</b></p> 
<p><b>Basket Animal.</b> Superficial and dry damage. Not very pronounced.</p>	<p>OPTIONAL - CAT2</p> 	<p><b>No</b></p> 



Minor Defects such as branching, lenticels, deformation, thrips and rubbing, may up to 20% of the total box can be tolerated, while major defects such as Basket Bug, Sun damage, Chimera, Without peduncle (Dry) will have a tolerance of 10% as long as they are slight and within the tolerances mentioned above (see images). Critical defects such as bird droppings, rodent damage, bites, sunblotch or blows have no tolerance for the packing.

The maximum tolerance of queresas is 10% of the sample.
